



San Roque Breaks Ground!



San Roque is a new construction multifamily property that will bring 137 one, two, and three bedroom apartments to the 400 block of Coors Boulevard. The project will also feature playground equipment, elevator, fitness room, business center, meeting room where support services or other counseling sessions can be conducted, and a large 4th floor patio with spectacular views. Other outdoor amenities include a dog park, raised community gardens, and a fenced perimeter with security gate.
